Dear Mr. Kesici,

The Aeronautical Authorities of the Russian Federation presents compliments to the Turkish Aeronautical Authorities and in response to your letter dated March 1, 2019 have the honor to inform as follows.

As a temporary measure to support airlines during the tough time of COVID-19 the Russian side proposes to increase the number of carriers on the routes Moscow – Bodrum and v.v. and Moscow – Dalaman and v.v. from 2 to 3 on a temporary basis until the end of the IATA Summer 2021 Season, providing the newly designated air carriers of each side with right to operate 7 frequencies per week on each of the mentioned lines.

In case of your agreement, we propose to consider the present letter and your positive response to it as a temporary agreement between the Aeronautical Authorities of Russia and Turkey.

We hope to continue mutually beneficial cooperation.

Dear Ms. PETROVA,

Turkish Directorate General of Civil Aviation presents compliments to Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation, Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation.

We have received your referenced letter regarding your proposal to introduce triple designation on Bodrum-Moscow v.v. and Dalaman-Moscow v.v. routes with weekly 7 frequencies for each of the designated carriers temporarily until the end of IATA 2021 Summer Season.

Your proposal is evaluated and we agree on to introduce triple designation on Bodrum-Moscow v.v. and Dalaman-Moscow v.v. routes temporarily.

Moreover, according to our records Turkish Airlines and Pegasus Airlines are already designated on Bodrum-Moscow and only Pegasus Airlines is designated on Dalaman-Moscow. Additionally, in accordance with Article 3 of Air Services Agreement signed between our countries on 12 May 2010; Turkish Directorate General of Civil Aviation designates Turkish Airlines, which is appropriately licensed by our Ministry, to operate scheduled services on the route of Dalaman-Moscow v.v.
